


Using a nostalgic memories from my childhood I created this abstract piece.









Dada inspired lettering, digital creation.

In response to the dire situation the earth is in at the moment due to mass consumerism and waste I have created these pieces that combine the skills I have gained throughout my foundation course.






Creative response to inspiration from exploring typography and the inspiration gained from my topic and Davide Bonazzi.




Andrew McGranahan inspired digital collage.
